PE & Sport Premium

FUNDING: At the time of writing we have no further information regarding the PE & Sport Premium for next academic year (2020-21). Our national partners at the Youth Sport Trust have been in contact with the Department for Education (DfE) regarding this, however they have understandably stated that Government capacity is currently being concentrated in other areas. As/when any information regarding this funding stream is made available, we will inform you all via special news bulletin e-mail. All official updates will be posted directly on the Government website (links below).

REPORTING: In the absence of definitive guidance, we would suggest schools adhere to the online report publication deadline of 31st July 2020. Remember, all schools are required to publish the following details on their school website by this date:

- the amount of premium received
- · a full breakdown of how it has been spent
- the impact the school has seen on pupils' PE, physical activity, and sport participation and attainment
- how the improvements will be sustainable in the future

At this stage, we would advise reporting on activity/spend that has taken place pre school closures and the associated spend. We currently recommend utilising the Association for Physical Education endorsed reporting template which can be found HERE.
