3. Leadership

Leadership Academy (Yr 7/8)*	This training opportunity has been designed to provide an introduction to Sports Leadership for Year 7 & 8 pupils. It is hoped that the delivery programme will equip Gateshead Secondary Schools with a lower KS3 'Young Leader Workforce' to assist with the delivery of primary school tournaments, festivals and events.	2
Leadership Workshop Day (Yr 8/9/10)	This 1-day training opportunity has been designed to provide more specialised leadership workshops focusing on specific areas of the sporting landscape, aimed at Year 8, 9 & 10 pupils. It is hoped that the range of workshops provided will build a knowledge base within these specialist areas, as well as developing generic leadership skills, pupil knowledge and experience.	8
Girls Participation Project	<p>This programme is designed to get more girls active in school. The chosen year 7 pupils will complete the project by planning and running their own club or event for other girls in their school. The pupils have access to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 full day of team building and activities at Gibside National Trust in the Summer Term to be introduced to the project. - Access to 1 hour of planning support from a GSSP team member in your school to plan the girls project. - A GSSP team member will attend the session or event planned by the girls. - Pupil incentives will include two items of branded clothing of attendance and completion of the project. 	8
